

TEAM LEADER REVALIDATION

This Course is to revalidate Team Leaders who have qualified in the JOIFF accredited 5 Day Team Leader Course when validity of certification ceases after 3 years.

PROGRAMME

Day 1:

Up to 10.30	Registration.
10.30 – 12.30	Introduction to Command and Control Procedures.
12.30 – 13.30	Lunch
13.30 – 15.00	Command and Control Procedures (practical).
15.00 – 15.30	Tea Break
15.30 – 17.00	Command and Control Procedures (practical).

Day 2:

Table top exercises, live fire scenarios.

Presentation and discussion on 4 potential Emergency scenarios

- an Incident in a Storage Tank followed by practical exercises.
- an Incident in a Process followed by practical exercises.
- an Incident involving an escape of toxic / flammable chemicals followed by practical exercises.
- a Fire / Explosion followed by practical exercises.

Day 3:

Operational Supervisory / Management of Incidents.

Students will work in Teams carrying out practical exercises.

08.30 – 10.00 Plan action to meet the needs of events.

- This element concerns the student's ability to prepare clear, realistic and appropriate plans for initial action to be taken to respond to events. It will include their plans for anticipated resource demands and their ability to allow sufficient flexibility and contingency planning for potential change as the event progresses.

10.00 – 10.30 Tea Break.

10.30 – 12.30 Implement action to meet planned objectives.

- This element concerns the student's ability to implement the plans they prepare to the objectives of the event. Students must demonstrate that they confirm objectives and deploy appropriate resources to meet both initial and changing needs of events whilst continuing to operate within their own level of competence and responsibility. It includes their ability to communicate clearly, concisely and with priority with a range of people.

12.30 – 13.30 Lunch

13.30 – 15.30 Debrief people following events.

- This element concerns the student's ability to conduct a debrief of both individuals and groups, including measurement and feedback of performance against specified standards relevant to work roles. It includes their ability to ensure that risk critical issues are addressed, that they recognise and support successful actions and that they communicate clearly, concisely and constructively with a range of people.

15.30 Course disperse

Note:

Re-validation will be certified for a period of 3 years during.

Management must be aware that it is their responsibility to ensure that their staff maintain their competencies. Therefore it is recommended that at least one day's practical firefighting must have taken place no later than 18 months after certification.
